

M. Opara - 75

famous Ukrainian scientist in the field of farming and Agricultural Chemistry, candidate of agricultural sciences, professor of earth-crops and agrochemicals, vice-rector of Poltava State Agrarian Academy Nikolai Nikolaevich today was 75 years old. The jubilee of the 23rd of July 1940 was born in the village. Moshny Cherkassy district of Cherkassy region. After graduating from Zolotonosh agricultural-technical college, he studied at the Poltava Agricultural Institute (PSCI) at the Agronomy Faculty. In his student years, he became involved in scientific activities: he participated in numerous conferences at various universities of Ukraine and the former Soviet Union. Subsequently, I entered the postgraduate study at the Faculty of Agrochemistry and Soil Science of the UHF. The further work of the scientist was connected with the training and training of agricultural workers, the introduction of a soil protection system of cultivation, in particular, unplowed cultivation, the revival of small villages in Poltava region. During 1988-1992, Nikolai Nikolaevich worked as a vice-rector of the Faculty of Advanced Studies of the UGCC. From 1992 to 2000 - General Director of the Scientific-Production Association "Elita" and head of the Center for scientific support of the APV of the Poltava region. Since 2000 MM Opara occupied the position of head of the center of agriculture and agrochemistry, vice-rector for scientific and pedagogical, scientific work at the Poltava State Agrarian Academy. Candidate of Agricultural Sciences on "Harvest and grain quality of winter wheat in the application of fertilizers in the calculation of yield" Nikolai Nikolaevich in 1975, academic titles of Associate Professor were awarded in the 1991 range of scientific interests. The scientist is wide-ranging and versatile. He constantly improves his head of research. Influence of growth regulators and various components of the modern organic farming (without tillage of soil, manure and fertilizer systems) on the yield and quality of crops, explores the role of various components of the modern organic farming system, in particular, short-term, and the impact of monoculture on the yield of individual agricultural crops. For over 40 years, Nikolai Nikolaevich has been conducting daily monitoring of the weather. MM Opara - author of 470 scientific and popular works, chief among which is the "Methodical recommendations on the introduction of a soil-protective and without tillage farming systems in the Poltava region," "Raising yield of oil per hectare", "On Farming in the conditions of increasing the dryness of the climate in Poltava region" and others. For contribution to the development of agricultural science and hard work bahatorichnu Nikolai Opara Udo-stoyenny honorary title of Honored Worker of the Ukrainian economy, honors awarded "Excellence in Agricultural Education and Science» III degrees, medals TS Maltsev, "For Labor Valor" Honor of the Ministry of Agriculture of Ukraine, certificates of the National Academy of Agrarian Sciences of Ukraine, Ministry of Agrarian Policy and Food of Ukraine.
