

O. Varchenko - 50

A well-known scientist-economist, doctor of agricultural sciences, a professor, an assistant professor of finance and credit department, director of the Institute of Economics and Business of the Bila Tserkva National Agrarian University, graduate of education in Ukraine Olga Mironovna Varghenko turned 50 years old. Olga Mironovna was born on March 3, 1965 in the village. Iza Khust district of Zakarpattia region. In 1987 he graduated from Kharkiv VV Agricultural-Economic Institute. Dokuchaev with honors. Since 1994, he has been working at the Bila Tserkivskyi State Agrarian University (now - Bila Tserkva National Agrarian University), successfully linking the practical pedagogical activity with scientific research. In 1993 O. M. Varchenko defends his thesis for obtaining the scientific degree of the candidate of economic sciences, and in 2005 - a doctorate on the problem of the formation and regulation of the sugar market in Ukraine. The new approaches to the development of the economic mechanism for regulating the activities of beet sugar industry entities aimed at creating conditions for the parity of price competition of domestic products are extremely important for science and practice. She developed a system of protection measures and support for domestic producers of beet sugar subcomplex through the introduction of a promissory note for the importation of cane raw sugar into the territory of Ukraine for processing it under tolling conditions. O.V. Varchenko predicted the impact on the domestic sugar beet sugar industry of strengthening the expansion of the world market of raw sugar exporters through the definition of the threshold of product production of sugar, ensuring the competitiveness of products on the world market. In 2009, under the direction of Olga Mironivna, the SDC No. 109 U 005969 "Certification of wholesale markets of agricultural products" was developed. In 1999 and 2012 O.M. Varchenko trained in the universities of Exeter (Great Britain) and the city of Gissen (Germany) on the problems of the formation and regulation of the agrarian market, agrarian marketing, and the improvement of the teaching methods in the higher vocational school. Currently, she is actively collaborating with the University of Cambridge and Ridding (Great Britain), who are studying the economy of sugar and sugar beet production. In 2008-2009 O.M. Varchenko was the coordinator of the international project Tempus III "The Concept of Sustainable Development in the Training of Specialists for Agriculture", which was carried out in cooperation with the National Institute for Higher Agricultural and Environmental Education and Food Technology, Dijon (France) And the Czech University of Life Sciences, Prague (Czech Republic). Among its scientific achievements there are more than 90 scientific works, in particular monographs: "The sugar market: an optimal combination of market and state regulation" (2004), "Experience of economic efficiency of sugar beet production in the UK and its use in Ukraine" (2001), "Pricing in the Process of Reforming the Agro-Industrial Complex of Ukraine" (1990-2001), "Global and domestic experience in sugar market regulation" (2009), "Fundamentals of Sustainable Development of the Agrarian Sector" (2010). Under her leadership 2 doctoral and 8 candidate dissertations were prepared. O.H.M. Varchenko is the author of three textbooks: Logistics, Financial Management. Since 2006, Olga Mironivna is a member of the editorial board and responsible for the publication of a collection of scientific works "The Bulletin of the Belocentrsky State Agrarian University", and since 2009 - a collection of scientific works "Economics and Management of AIC", the head NMC of agrarian education in economics and management. Since 2008 O.M. Varchenko - Deputy Head of the Specialized Academic Council D 27.821.03 for the defense of doctoral and candidate's theses.
